


QR-Patrol Microsoft Power BI Accessibility Manual

Import Data from QR-Patrol REST API

To import data into Microsoft Power BI via QR-Patrol REST API Calls follow the next steps:

- Open the Power BI Dashboard and select the **Get Data -> Web** option
- You will be navigated to a new window where you must configure the task. Select the **Advanced** option.

- For the URL you need to visit the QR-Patrol REST API (<https://ws.followmystaff.com/api/docs/v3>) and go to the **Authentication** call.
- There you will need to enter your Web App Credentials to get the access token back.

- After obtaining the token, you must place it on the right top of the page in the **Explore** area (without the curly brackets), press Enter and start working with your API calls.

- Select the Data you want to work with and copy the URL created.
- Paste the URL from the API page to the Power BI window.
- Enter the token as a HTTP request header parameter in the form of **x-access-token**.
- Your Power BI window should look like this:
